### WorkReady Subsidised Training Place

### WorkReady Subsidised Training Place – with Concession<sup>^</sup>

WorkReady Students may be eligible for a concession if they are:

- > A current Commonwealth Government concession card holder:
  - > Health Care Card; or
  - > Pensioner Concession Card; or
  - > Veteran Affairs Concession Card.
- > A prisoner in a South Australian correctional institution
- > Not employed and not enrolled in a secondary school
- > Aged between 16 to 24 years and not enrolled in secondary school.
