Course overview

Regional Skills Training (RST) provides Chemical Accreditation training.

All participants are required to complete both a theory and practical assessment to achieve chemical accreditation to purchase and use Schedule 7 chemicals if they are over the age of 18.

On successful completion of the course, participants will be issued with a Spray Solutions card and statement of attainment for the following units:

- > AHCCHM307 **Prepare and apply chemicals to control pest, weeds and diseases**
- > AHCCHM304 **Transport and store chemicals**

DELIVERY METHODS AND COURSE FEES

You can complete your Spray Solutions training via one of three ways:

1. OPEN LEARNING

Plus video/photo evidence

The open learning program is designed to allow the participant to work at their own pace in their own home or business(i). Participants receive the current Spray Solutions Reference Manual which they may keep for future reference.

Participants must complete and submit:

- > Student Declaration
- > Theory assessment
- > Practical tasks demonstrations recorded on video and photos

Instructions on providing evidence will be included in your Spray Solutions Chemical Accreditation pack.

2. HALF DAY WORKSHOP

Plus open learning theory

A combination of a half day workshop and open learning theory. This method is designed to allow a group of 10 or more participants to meet at a local venue with our assessor who will complete practical assessments on the day. Participants will be issued the Spray Solutions Reference Manual and theory assessment to take home and complete in their own time⁽ⁱ⁾.

Participants must complete and submit:

- > Student declaration
- > Theory assessment
- > Practical assessments are completed at the workshop

3. TWO DAY WORKSHOP

For inexperienced operators

Participants attend a two day workshop which comprises all training and assessment required. This delivery is face to face and held in regional locations with workshops held as per demand.

(i) The time to complete the assessment is expected to be 10 to 20 hours.

An SSO will be available to students for support during your training

(ii) RST provides the Department for Health and Ageing current records of all participants who have completed Chemical Accreditation. Information must be updated annually or on demand. The information is to allow the Department to conduct audits to ensure people purchasing, transporting and using Schedule 7 chemicals have current accreditation.

(iii) Students need to wear work boots and appropriate work wear for practical workshops. They also must have access to the internet, a laptop, tablet or smart phone.

STUDENT SUITABILITY & SUPPORT NEEDS

A suitability and support review will be completed as part of the enrolment process. Students may need to complete a language, literacy and numeracy assessment prior to enrolment in the course. Where support needs are identified, RST will work with you to put an appropriate support plan in place.

SPRAY SOLUTION REFRESHER COURSE

Every 5 years holders of a spray solutions ticket have to complete a refresher course to renew their ticket.

Students can complete this refresher training via one of the following delivery methods:

FACE TO FACE:

1 day face to face workshop in an area where sufficient demand is identified in your local region.

OPEN LEARNING

Resources and assessments are sent to you via email or post which must be completed and returned to RST. This involves a theory assessment as well as practical task demonstrations recorded in videos and photos.
